



Farm Trail

Today you will meet lots of animals that live on the farm.


Let's start with the pigs.

Fun fact – female pigs are called sows and male pigs are called boars.

Can you spot the dairy cows?


We have two types of dairy cows on the farm. They are *Ayrshire* and *Jersey*. Their milk is extra creamy.

Now to the chickens.

We have three types of chicken called *Scots Dumpy*, *White Leghorn* and *Black Rocks*.

Fun fact - the farmer can tell which chicken laid which egg - the shell is the same colour as their ears!


Let's head up to the calves.

The calves are in the Small Byre, which is like the baby room in a nursery. Remember to be quiet, they might be sleeping.

Now to see our horses.

Our horses are Clydedale horses – they have hairy hooves!





Female sheep are pregnant for four months, four weeks and four days. They give birth to lambs.

Pregnant sheep usually give birth to twins and triplets, so we have lots of lambs in Spring time.
