


How to draw Manfred the mammoth







1. First draw a wonky square, on a nice piece of paper, this...


2. Then add two rectangles, like this...




3. Now draw a chunky 'r' shape coming out of the bottom left of your wonky square and another rectangle between the first two you drew.



4. After that, add an oval shape to the top left corner of your wonky square.




5. ...and add a back-to-front 'J' on to this (this will be Manfred's trunk!). If you can, make it the length shown here.




6. Next draw the tusks, two long thin banana shapes are perfect!

7. Add a little friendly eye...



8. ...then an ear, this is a bit like a frilly, back-to-front 'C'.

9. Now all you have to do is pad him out a bit, to make him look like this! Don't forget about his tail!

The final touch - lots of thick woolly fur, made up of lots of scribbles. Don't forget the tufts on top of his head - have fun!
